



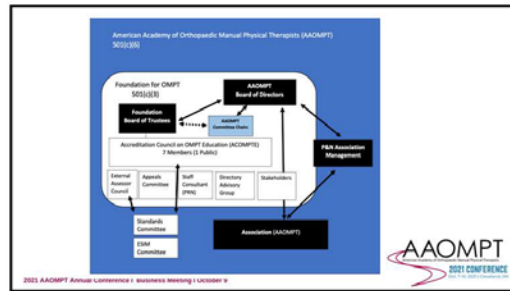

**Objectives**

The scientific vision of ICMT is limited to the following high priority research areas:

1. Terminology and measurement of force-based manipulations: Develop common terminology and metrics to characterize, uniformly define, and quantify the types of manual force applied to various manual therapies, such as mobilization, myofascial release, massage therapy, etc. Clinical and evidence-based measures of force, stress, strain, stiffness and the response to force at multiple levels of analysis (force, muscle, soft-tissue and bone). Determine biomechanical and neural mechanisms, and their variation across the human and animal population subspecies (e.g., chronic pain patients).
2. Mechanistic research on the neural circuitry of force-based manipulations: Identify and quantify neural circuitry involved in force-based manipulations.
3. Contextual effects of force-based manipulations: Define and quantify neural outcomes such as psychophysical, affective, and perceptual effects on various neural circuits of force-based manipulations.
4. Biomarkers of force-based manipulations: Identify biomarkers for short- and long-term therapeutic responses to force-based manipulations in the context of appropriate human and animal models (e.g., low back pain, osteoarthritis, pain syndromes).
5. Technology and methodology development for mechanistic studies.

The outcome of this effort will be presented at the inaugural ICMT conference at the University of Arizona College of Medicine in Phoenix, AZ, thanks to the efforts of Paul Standley. While many aspects of the preparation have gone well, there are **2 areas of weakness** that I have been trying to address for some time now. Of the five manual therapy professions, we have over 6 members from the chiropractic, osteopathic, massage therapy and structural integration professions. **Currently we have only one representative from the physical therapy profession.** So I am hoping you can help identify a few manual therapy PTs who will be able to represent the PT field within this process.

### 2020 vs. 2021 Membership







- 2004:** IFOMPT defined OMPT as a specialized area of physiotherapy using a comprehensive biopsychosocial approach
- 2015:** Singapore WCPT Conference--IFOMPT open forum on name change
- 2016:** Glasgow -- informal straw poll of MO delegates on IFOMPT name change and 50% were opposed.
