
Foundation of Orthopedic Manual Physical Therapy (FOMPT)


Report to AAOMPT Membership – October 28, 2022

FOMPT sponsored the Silent Auction at AAOMPT conference and a fund raising boat cruise on 26 October

Action statements from FOMPT objectives are:

EDUCATON: We invest in multimedia efforts at clinic. community, national levels to demonstrate the value and caring of orthopaedic manual Physical Therapists.

OUTCOME: Two podcasts were developed by Skip Gill involving our colleagues Gayle Deyle and Tim Flynn

RESEARCH: We help finance research to advance the orthopaedic Physical Therapist's knowledge base.

OUTCOME: We have accepted financial donation from The Paris Foundation towards funds for research. We look forward to working with AAOMPT research committee in 2023 for distribution of these funds.

SCHOLARSHIPS: We help finance scholarship/grants to assist Physical Therapists' knowledge base.

OUTCOME: At the 27 October 2022 FOMPT meeting the motion was unanimously passed as:

FOMPT to annually fund, starting in 2023, scholarships for current and future Fellows-in-Training to be applied towards tuition costs.

COLLABORATION: We work with and support AAOMPT committees to accelerate education, research and advocacy of OMPT.

OUTCOME: Each Trustees is assigned to dialogue with specific AAOMPT committee members regarding these committees' projects that may need funding.

ADVOCACY: We advocate for patient access to and sustainable income for orthopaedic manual Physical Therapists.
