Task Force to Develop the AAOMPT Definition of OMPT

Orthopedic Manual Physical Therapy (OMPT) is a systematic and structured approach to patient care that utilizes advanced clinical reasoning, fosters a collaborative patient-provider alliance, and facilitates active patient participation to optimize movement and function through patient education, individualized exercise therapy, and skillfully prescribed hands-on manual therapy. OMPT is a patient-centered approach and uses a biopsychosocial framework with a focus on health promotion.

Orthopedic Manual Physical Therapy can be taught at a basic competency level in first professional programs, at an experienced level in postgraduate or residency training, and provides the framework for expert practice following fellowship training.

Research Award

The Clinical Science in Manual Therapy award is intended to support clinically focused research that serves to advance the practice and clinical implementation of manual therapies in addition to growing the base of high-quality evidence related to manual therapy.

HISTORY

The Foundation for OMPT Research Steering Task Force along with donors identified needs for more clinically focused research and established the Clinical Science in Manual Therapy Research Award. Through research of well-known and established processes, surveys, task forces, and a roundtable discussion, the CSMT Program was created.

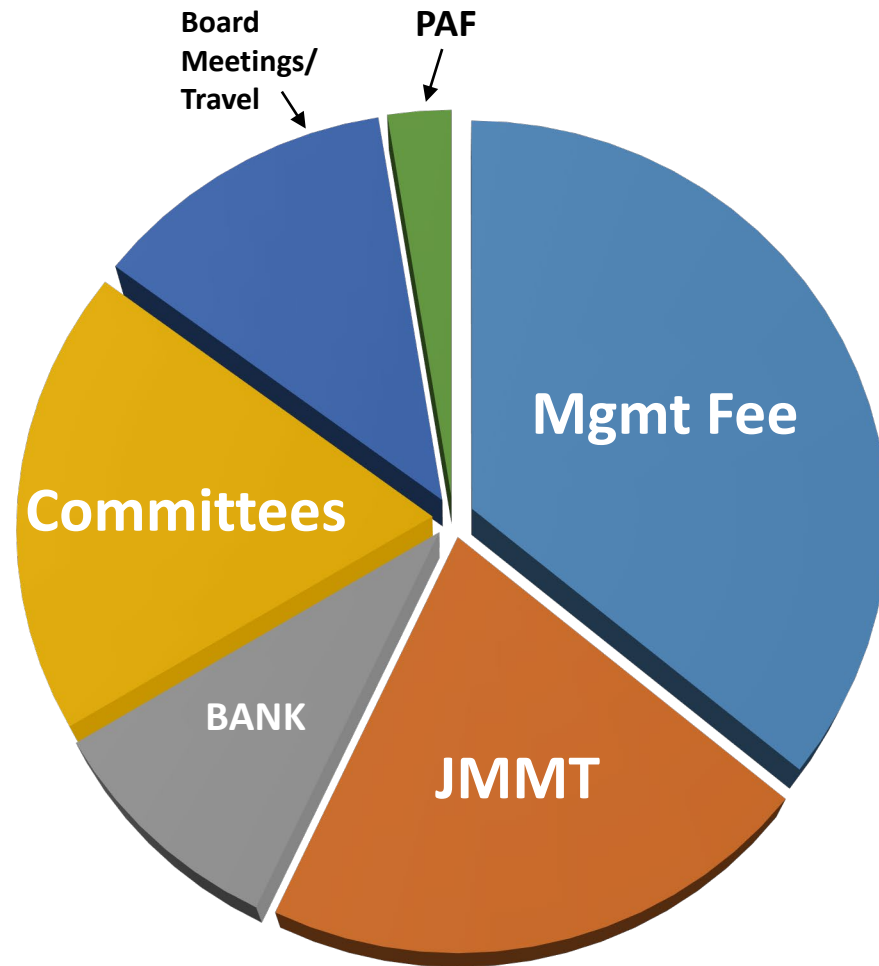
2022 Non-Conference Revenue Budgeted

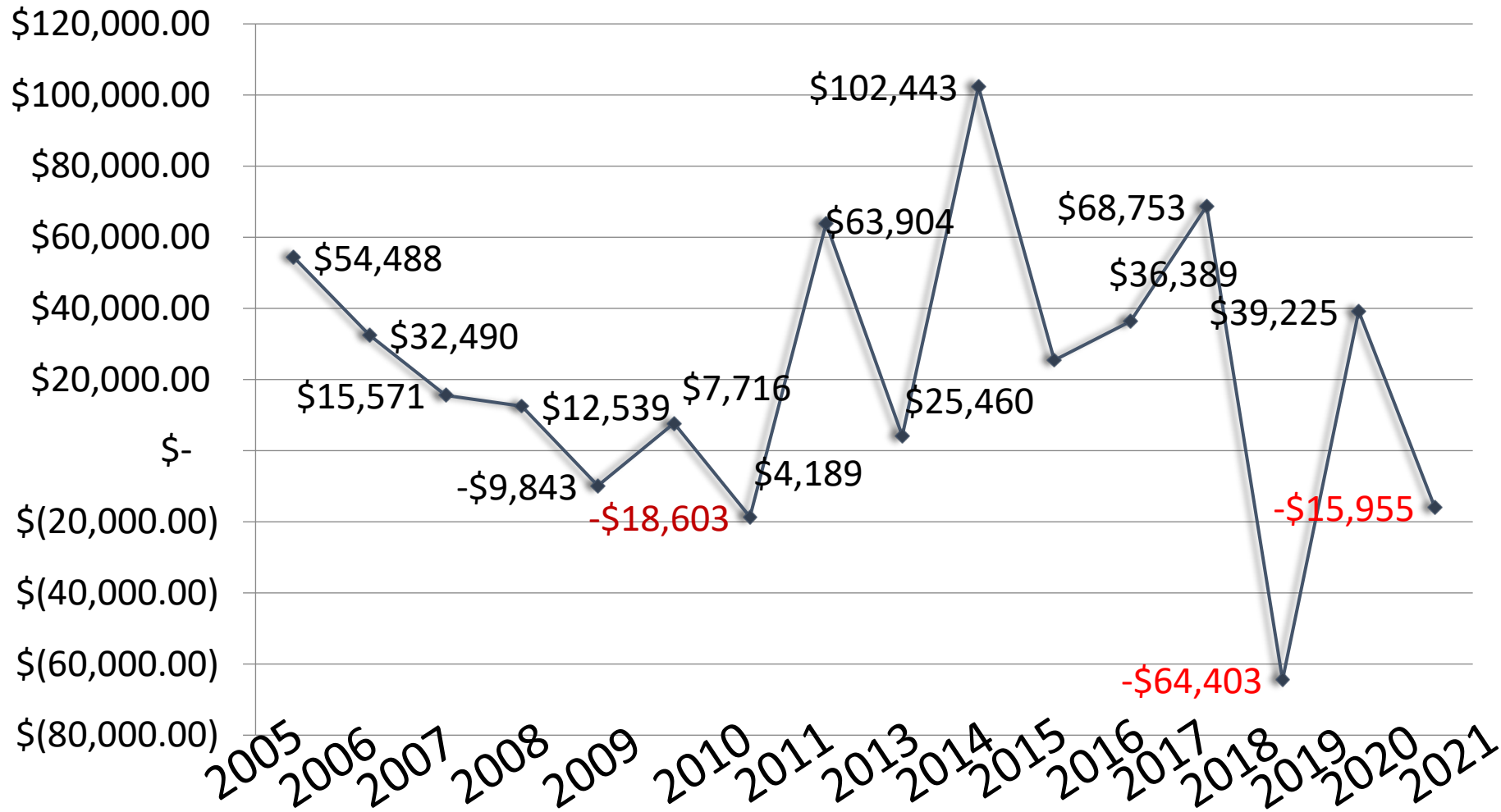

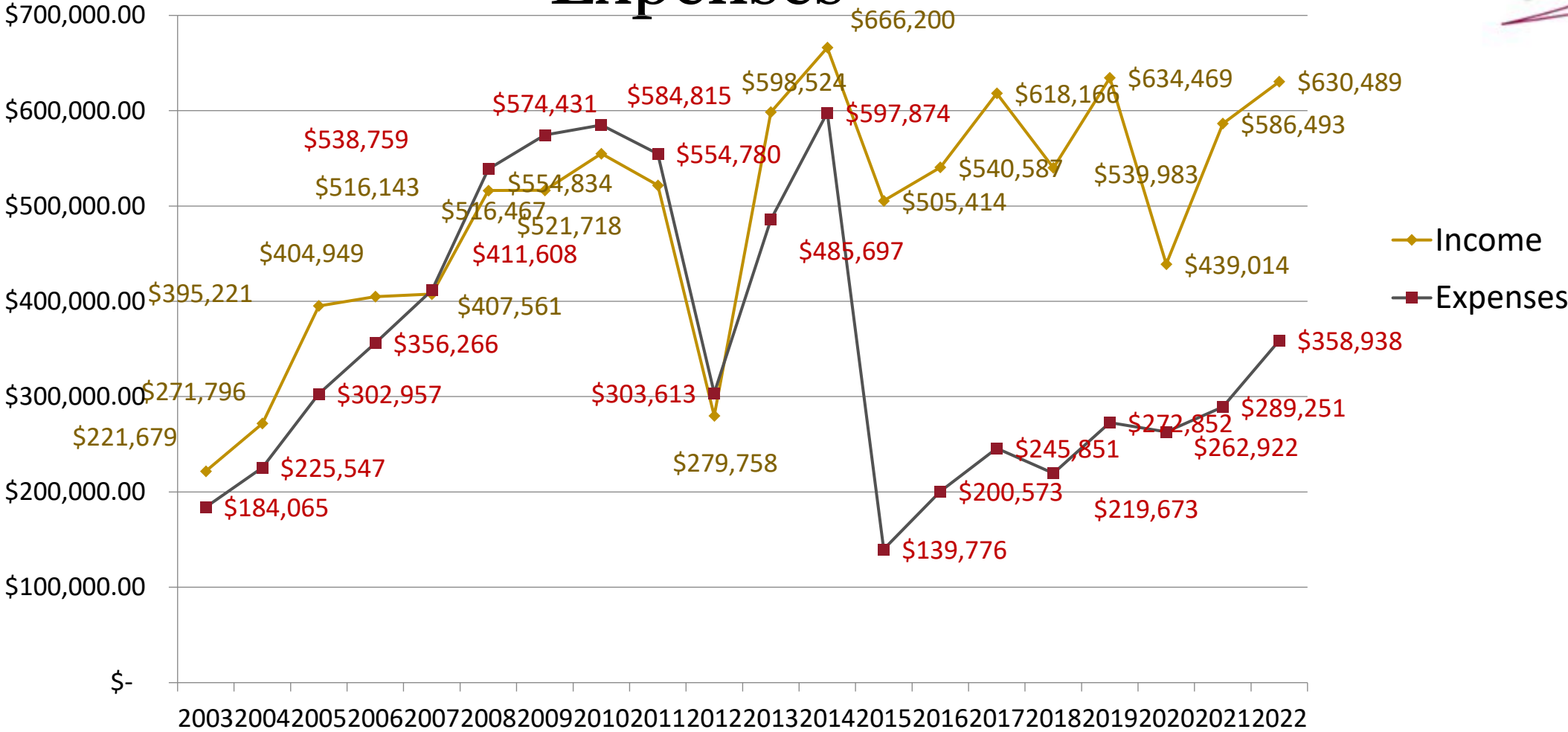

As of 08/31 - Historical Income and Expenses

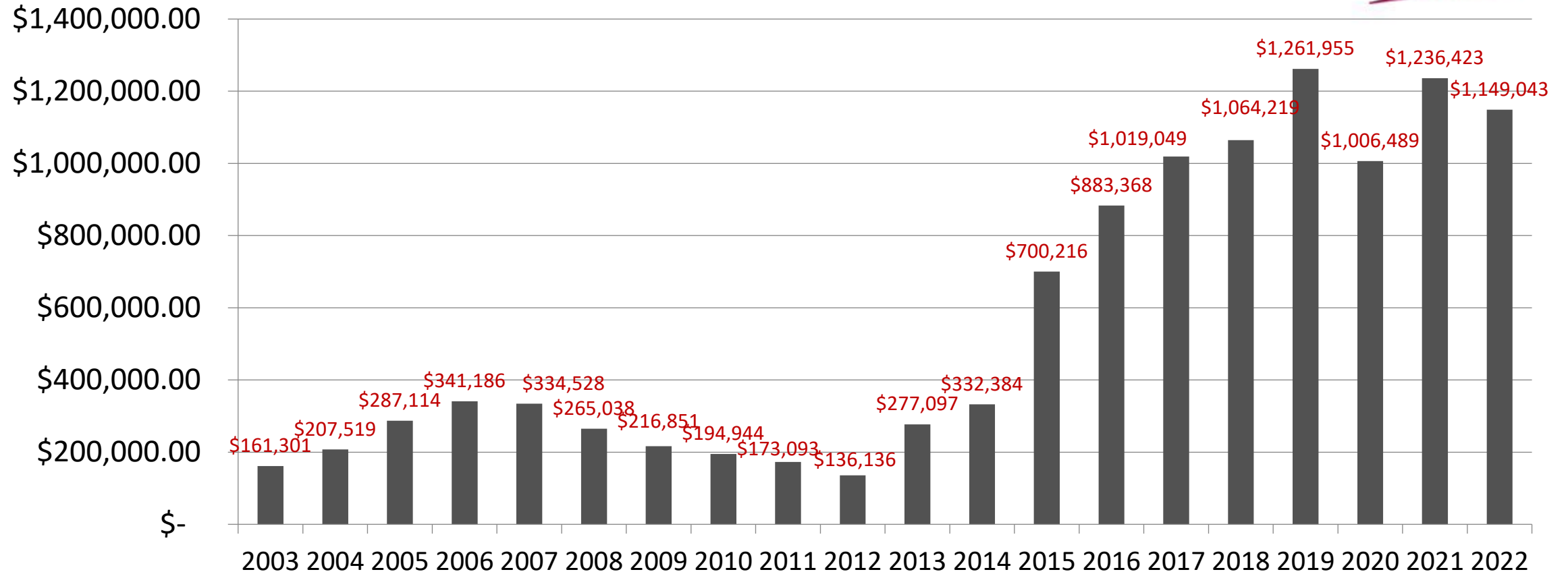

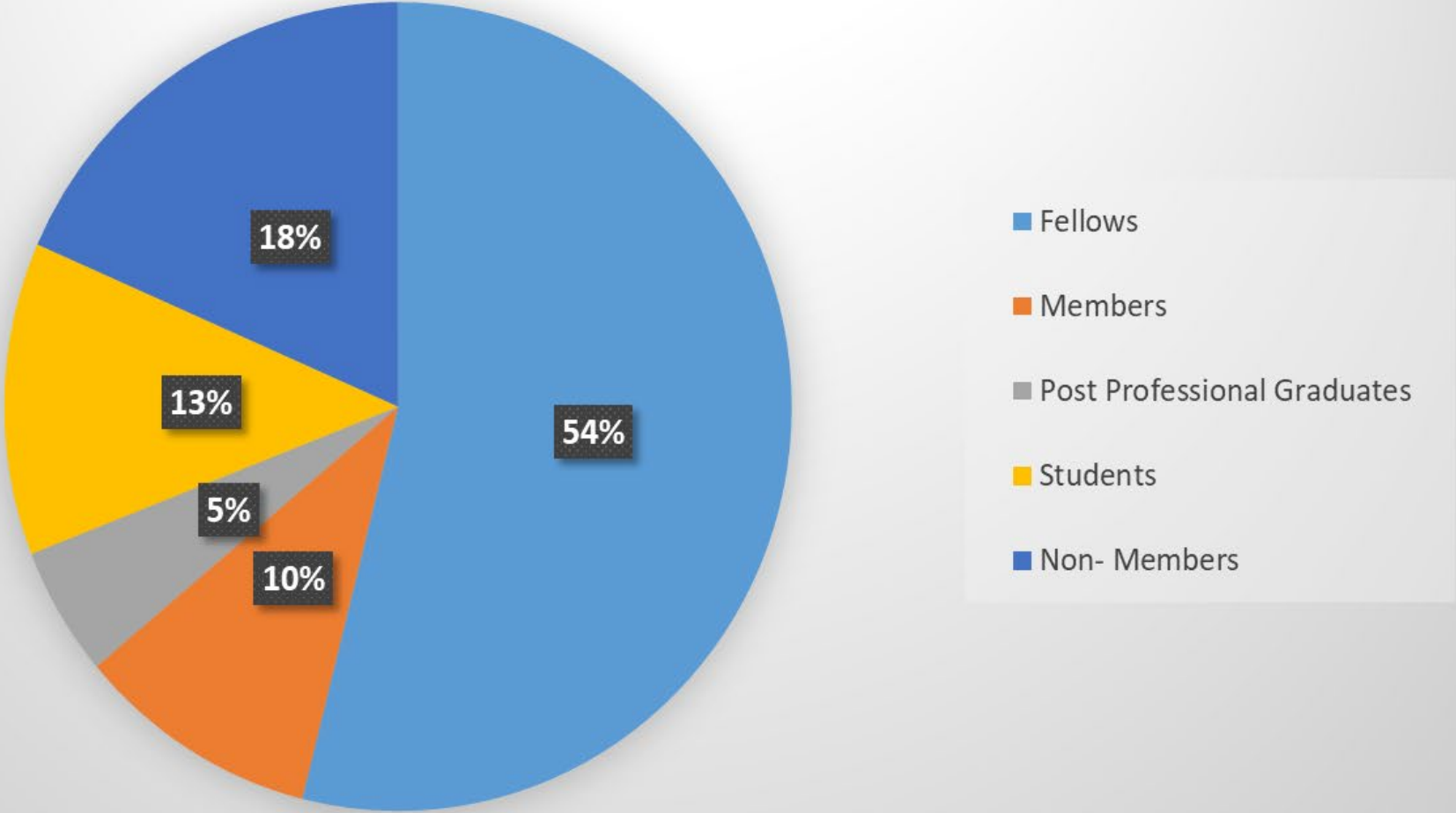

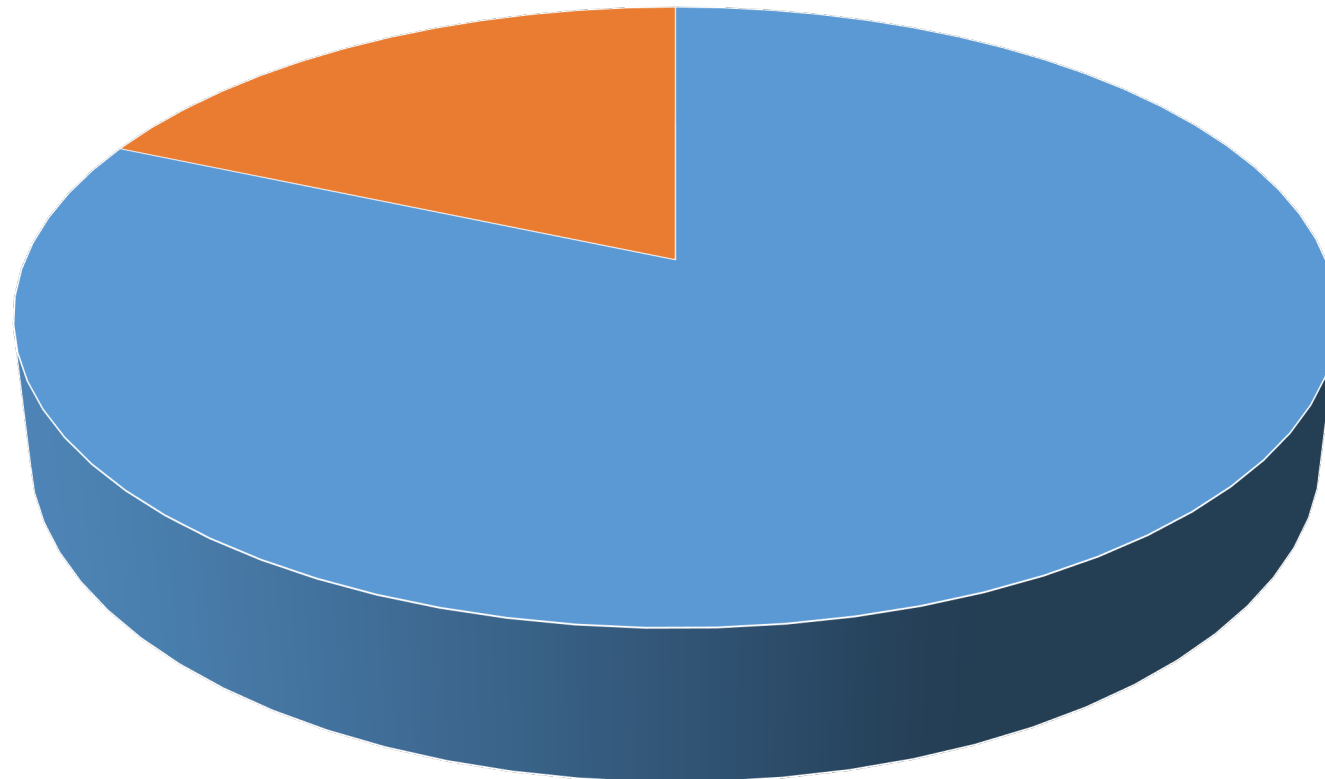

Non-Members (orange) vs. Members (blue)



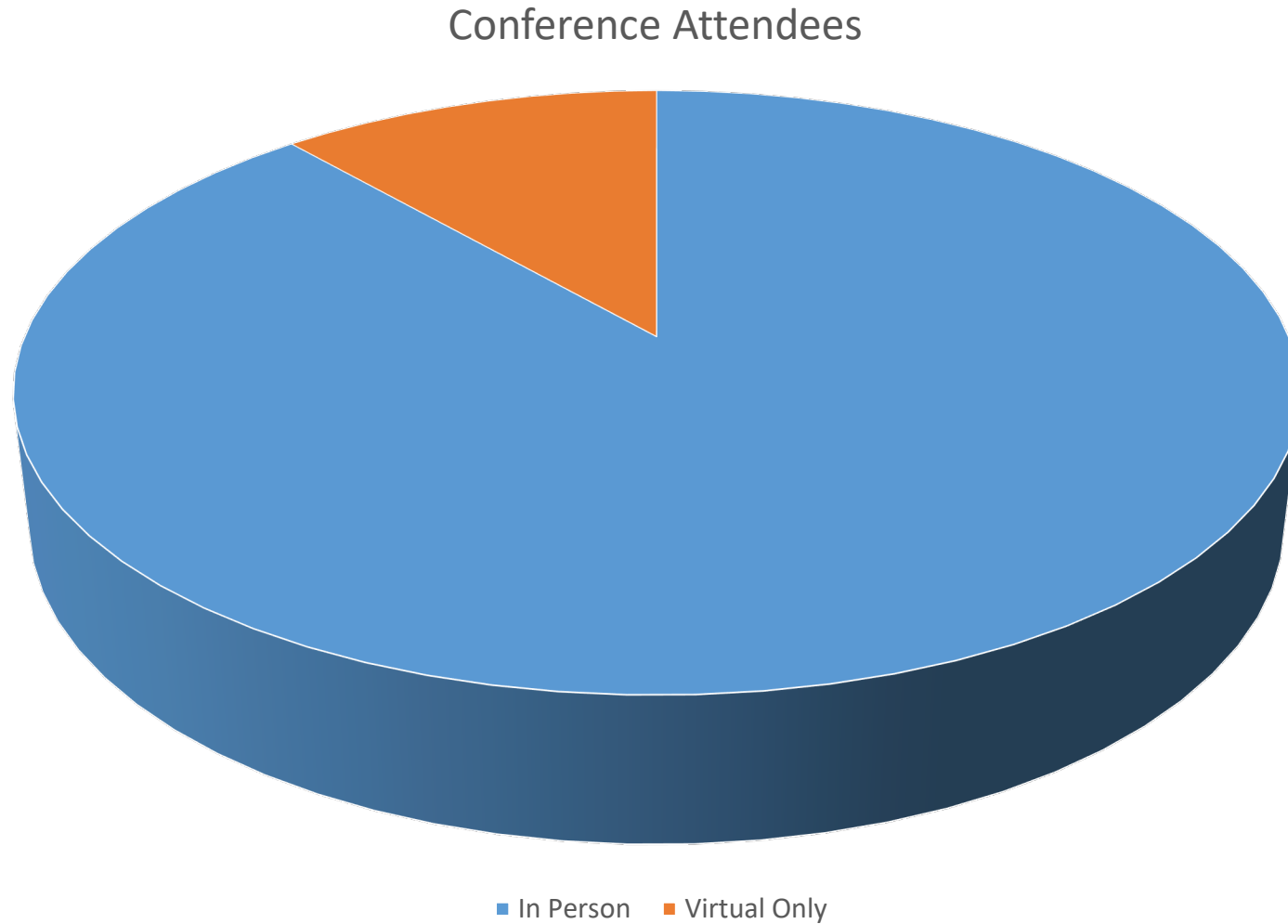

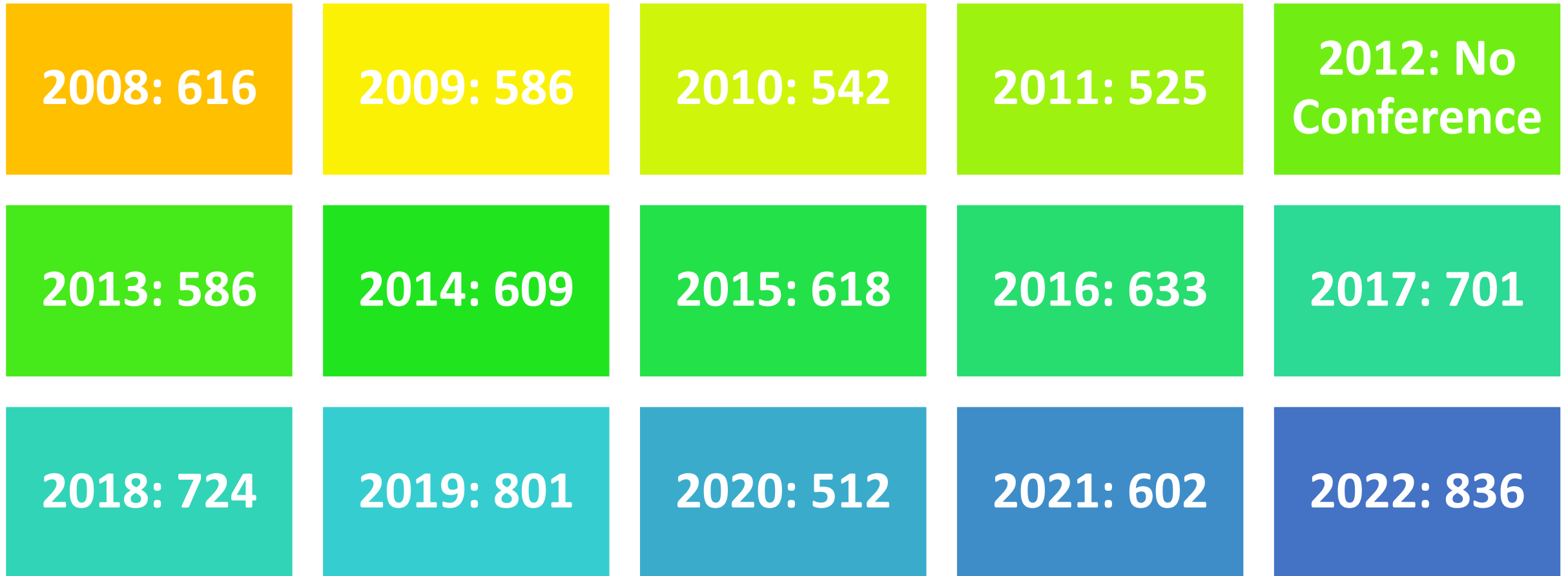

Motion: Proposed Membership Dues Increase

Motion: To increase the membership dues in 2023 for the Fellow membership category to \$180 and Member category to \$150.

Rationale: Currently Fellowship Membership is \$155, and Membership Category is \$125. Student membership remains \$15. There has not been a dues increase since 2009. A dues increase to match the inflationary rate of 2.51% annually would increase it to \$215, we are proposing an increase of \$25 for both Fellows and Members.
