AAOMPT Excellence in Research Award

Eligibility:

The published article must appear in a reputable, peer-reviewed scientific journal between June 1, 2023, and May 31, 2024. E-pub and in-press articles are not eligible as they do not have a formal journal issue number, where the date for eligibility can be confirmed.

Selection Criteria:

The research paper should have a significant impact on the practice of orthopaedic manual physical therapy, either immediately or potentially. Eligible papers must be clinical research reports that summarize clinical research directly relevant to orthopaedic manual physical therapy. Single clinical case studies or literature reviews will not be considered.

Nomination Process:

The AAOMPT Research Committee will review all published research papers related to orthopaedic manual physical therapy. AAOMPT members can also nominate papers for consideration by submitting a nomination to the AAOMPT Research Committee Chairs by June 30, 2024:

The Award:

The award will consist of a plaque to be presented at the Awards Ceremony at the AAOMPT Annual Conference in Orlando, Florida, October 23-27, 2024. The presenting author will also receive complimentary full conference registration and travel to present at the conference (airfare, 1 night hotel, and complimentary registration). This will be with the expectation to present their research at the Conference in the method chosen by the Research Committee. All other authors on the paper will receive an award certificate.
